**Why Farmers?** Because we feel farming is important. Besides, it's awesome.

Our gardens are at the Pan Am Forest, north of the Pan Am Pool on Grant Ave. This food is grown on public land where people can explore at their leisure. Feel free to go check it out anytime!

**Community Shared Agriculture (CSA)** – It's a way of knowing how and where our food comes from, getting to know your farmers, sharing the risks of farming, being aware of our environment.

**How it works:** Sharers buy a share of the vegetables that we plant in spring. We, in turn deliver weekly boxes of fresh, organic, in season vegetables **TO YOUR DOOR, WITH OUR BIKES.** We Deliver to homes in the the following neighborhoods: River Heights, Fort Rouge, Osborne, West Broadway, Wolesley, West End, Downtown, Spence Neighborhood. Your share will feed 2-4 people depending on how much you love the crunch of a fresh carrot.

Your share will contain what nature can provide, whether it be an explosive harvest, whatever can survive an onslaught of hail, a night of bored rowdy high school kids, or grannies from a time where food was shared. A weekly newsletter will give you a glimpse into the haps on the farm. Our Winnipeg climate offers us 13-14 weeks of deliveries. We will steward the fields of vegetables all season long even if you don't see certain items in your delivery box. Some variables are out of our hands. The risk of agriculture is thus shared.

The cost of our share is \$480, plus \$70 for 12-13 weeks of pedal powered delivery. **Totaling \$550.** If this is cost-prohibitive, please contact us to discuss options.
